Bands at Parkside JHS

Symphonic Band

The Symphonic Band is comprised of musicians in eighth grade. They perform at PJHS concerts in addition to traveling to festivals throughout the year. The Symphonic Band rehearses daily during third hour.

Concert Band

The Concert Band is comprised of musicians in seventh grade. They perform at PJHS concerts in addition to traveling to festivals throughout the year. The Concert Band rehearses daily during fourth hour.

Cadet Band

The Cadet Band is comprised of musicians in sixth grade. They perform at PJHS concerts in addition to traveling to festivals throughout the year. The Cadent Band rehearses daily during first hour.

5th Grade Band

The 5th Grade Band is comprised of musicians in fifth grade. They perform at least two concerts throughout the year. The 5th Grade Band rehearses daily during 8th hour.

Honor Band

The Honor Band is comprised of the most elite musicians at PJHS by invitation. They perform at PJHS concerts in addition to traveling to prestigious festivals throughout the year. The Honor Band rehearses outside of the school day during the winter and spring seasons.

Jazz Band

The Jazz Band is comprised of musicians from all grade levels. They perform at Unit Jazz Concerts in addition to touring the Elementary Schools in the spring. The Jazz Band rehearses outside of the school day.

Percussion Ensemble

The Percussion Ensemble is comprised of percussionists from all grade levels. They meet during regularly scheduled band classes. Additional morning rehearsals may take place in preparation for performances. These groups will perform music written specifically for percussion instruments.

Required Materials

The following materials are required and expected to be with students in class:

- Snark Tuner
- Sharpened pencil
- Instrument and supplies (reeds, valve oil, stick bag, etc.)
- All students will need to turn in \$26.00 to Mrs. Bolton for the rental of their method book
- Folder containing music and the method book (Bach and Before)
- ▲ Laptops on various days

Music Folders

Each musician will be issued a music folder containing current music and other necessary class materials. Folders are to be stored in the assigned folder slots in the cabinets located inside the band room. Storing folders in instrument cases or in the instrument storage rooms can cause damage. Students are highly encouraged to take their folders home for regular practice sessions. Remember, students must bring the folders back to class!

Students will be charged for lost or damaged music (just like text books for other classes). Typical replacement costs for a lot folder are approximately \$30 because individual parts are special order.

Instrument Storage

Each musician's instrument should be clearly marked with his/her name. Instruments should be brought to the band room before school begins each day to be stored in one of our two instrument storage rooms. Each instrument has an assigned storage location based on the musician's grade and what type of instrument the student plays. Be sure to store your instrument in the correct location!

School Owned Instruments

School owned instruments are issued at the beginning of each year. All instruments have been cleaned and tuned/adjusted since the prior school year. Additional information and policies regarding school owned instruments are outlined on the Instrument Contract that is issued as the instrument is checked out for the year. Be sure to complete, sing, and return the Contract at the beginning of the school year.

Additional events may be scheduled as the year progresses. Families will be notified of any changes or additions to the published dates as soon as they are made. The most current calendar is available at the band website – www.parksidebands.com.

Attendance at all performances is expected because it is vital to the band's success. When a musician is absent, important individual parts are missed which affects the entire group performance.

You will need to complete a Performance Conflict Form as soon as you are aware of a conflict (a two week notice or more is required). Absences will be excused at the Director's discretion for the following reasons:

- ♪ Illness
- ♪ Death in the family
- ♪ Immediate family wedding
- ☐ Conflicts with other school-related events.

In most cases, school-related conflicts can be resolved between the Band Director and the Coach/Sponsor. Unexcused absences from a performance will have a severely negative effect on the student's grade.

I hope to assist in resolving any scheduling conflicts as they arise. Please contact me as early as possible!

Concert Attire

All musicians are required to wear the following uniform for performances:

- Gentlemen: Black uniform shirt (supplied by Mrs. Bolton), black dress pants/slacks (if your pants have belt loops, please wear a black belt), black knee length socks/hose & solid black shoes (closed-toe, dress shoes are required)
- → Ladies: Black uniform dress (supplied by Mrs. Bolton), black knee length socks/hose & solid black shoes (closed-toe, dress shoes are required)
- ♪ Ladies with pierced ears may wear small earrings that do not detract from the performance.

As students age and change sizes quickly, we recommend that a lot of money not be spent on the uniform. Pants, socks, and shoes are available for very reasonable prices at Walmart, Target, Payless, etc. Please contact Mrs. Bolton if you are in need of financial assistance to obtain uniform components.

Private Study

The fastest way for a student to progress musically is through private study with a specialist in his/her instrument. We encourage students at all levels to consider this opportunity to increase their knowledge and musicality. A list of teachers is provided below.
